ndaLink

Connect your smartphone to HondaLink featuring Aha by Harman so you can enjoy in-vehicle internet radio, podcasts, audiobooks, location-based services powered by Yelp and social media like Facebook and Twitter.

Before You Begin.

A. Download the App

Get the HondaLink App from your smartphone app store:

iPhone:



Android:



Tap on your smartphone's app store icon and type HondaLink in the search bar.

B. Register with HondaLink and Aha

Launch the App on your smartphone. Tap Register and follow the sign-up prompts:

- Register for **HondaLink**
- Register for **Aha** or connect to an existing Aha account.
- A Welcome E-mail will be sent to you with confirmation verification.

HondaLink Touchpoints

An overview of all the components in the HondaLink system.

i-MID Display

Detailed information and options on a selected Aha station.

HondaLink with Audio Touchscreen

- Navigate your customized Aha stations. Press the screen icons.
- i-MID Selector Knob ▶
 - Navigate the i-MID display options.

Settings

▶ Pair a phone and connect to HondaLink via Bluetooth through vehicle settings.

USB Port

- Connect your iPhone to HondaLink via USB tethering.
- ▶ Connect your compatible phone to HondaLink to play Aha internet radio.
- Customize your Aha stations with the free HondaLink app.



Customize Add and delete stations in the HondaLink app by following the steps of this example.

Step 1. Find a Station

- A. Launch and login to the **HondaLink app** on your smartphone
- B. Tap

to search or browse stations.

to find NPR: Hourly Newscast,

the example station that you will add.

Step 2. Add a Station to your Station List

A. Tap

from the stations listed.



The station will now appear in your presets.

Step 3. Create Starred Stations

- A. Tap the back arrow until you reach the main page, where your presets will now be placed. NPR: Hourly Newscast will now be located here.
- **B.** Tap the **star adjacent** to the station to make it a starred station for in-vehicle streaming.

Note: You must create a Starred Stations list in order to access your stations on the Audio Touchscreen. You can choose up to 16 Starred Stations.

Step 4. Delete Stations from your Lists

- A. Tap the edit button at any time to remove or re-order stations.
- B. Tap on the empty circle to remove a station and Delete.



Adding Facebook, Twitter or Slacker

- A. Tap **Settings** in the upper right corner of the App.
- B. Tap Associated Accounts.

- Choose Facebook, Twitter or Slacker Radio and Login to your account.
- **D.** Add them to your Stations list and/or Starred Stations following directions above.

B. Press

Smartphone Connection Set-Up

- A. Choose a connection method:
 - Android Bluetooth only.
 - iPhone USB or Bluetooth.
- C. Select Audio Settings

i-MID Display.

D. Select Priority Connection. Set it to Bluetooth or USB, depending on which connection method

you will be using.



Step 2.

Connect via USB (iPhone only)

- A. Log in to the HondaLink app.
- B. Plug in USB cable to the iPhone. Connect to the USB port outlet in the vehicle as shown in the picture.



Connect via Bluetooth

- A. Pair your phone. See the 2013 Honda Accord-Technology Reference Guide for instructions.
- B. Log in to the HondaLink app.
- C. Press the Micon on the Audio Touchscreen.
- **D.** Follow the prompts to select your device.



Play your favorite stations in the vehicle by following these steps.



Step 1.

Set-Up

- A. Turn the car on to Accessory mode or start the ignition.
- **B.** Log in to the HondaLink app on your Bluetooth or USB connected smartphone.



Step 2. **Select a Station**

- A. Press Ma Aha on the Audio Touchscreen from the menu. HondaLink automatically
- B. Select and press the **NPR: Hourly Newscast** station icon on the Audio Touch Screen.

Step 3.

Play Station

- A. Press the Play button.
- B. To adjust your screen and sound settings press
- C. Press to return to vour list of stations OR Press to return to the main menu.
- D. Use the selector knob to view more information and options on the i-MID Display



Step 4.

Disconnect

- A. Disconnect the USB cable if using USB.
- B. Tap the back arrow until you reach the main page.
- C. Tap the arrow 🗐 to logout of HondaLink.
